We have included a brief synopsis of the film below:

The explosion of violence in the UK this summer brought the British far right to the attention of the world.

In **UNDERCOVER Exposing the far right**, anti-extremist organisation HOPE not hate has allowed a film crew to follow its dangerous but essential undercover work for the first time.

UNDERCOVER Exposing the far right is an explosive new documentary film that is essential viewing for anyone who wants to understand how we got to the UK's racially motivated riots in the summer of 2024 and what needs to happen next.

FIRMING UP THE GUEST LIST



Before you host your event, have a think about who you would like to invite.

Questions to consider include:

Who may be interested in learning about the undercurrents of far-right activity in the UK?

Who would not normally engage with this kind of film but change their mind after watching it?

Who would be interested in having an open discussion and potentially taking action after watching UNDERCOVER?

CONVERSATION STARTERS

Below are a series of questions to help spark these vital conversations.

Pre-screening questions:

- How much of a threat do you think the far right is in our community?
- Do you have personal experience of far-right activity in your area?
- To what extent do you think far-right rhetoric and ideology is becoming normalised?
- What do the summer riots tell us about the rise of the far right in the UK?

Post-screening questions:

- · Which scene in the film spoke to you most?
- How has your perception of the far-right threat changed since watching the film?
- How did the experiences of the HOPE not hate campaigners resonate with you?
- · What can politicians do to take action against extremism?
- What do you think should be done about the spread of hate online? Who needs to take action on this?
- What actions do you think you can take to combat the rise of far-right extremism in your community?
- Has the film encouraged you to take action in your local community? If so, why?
